

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

### 2012 Millpond Trail Improvements Mt. Pleasant, Michigan, 48858

The City of Mt. Pleasant is requesting sealed Bids at the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 320 W. Broadway St., Mt. Pleasant, MI 48858 until 1:30 pm on July 31, 2012 at which time and place the bids will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, plainly marked "Bid Enclosed - 2012 Millpond Trail Improvements – July 31, 2012."

The work generally involves: Improvement of an existing pedestrian / bike trail and the existing bridges and railings. Items include HMA Base Crushing and Shaping, HMA pavement, timber railing, a new pedestrian bridge, and SESC.

A non-refundable \$25.00 fee is required for plans and specifications picked up at the Mt. Pleasant Parks office, 320 W. Broadway Street, Mt. Pleasant, Michigan 48858, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. A non-refundable \$30.00 fee is required for plans and specifications that are mailed.

Bid documents will be available starting Monday July 16, 2012.

Bid Security in the form of a Certified or Cashier's Check or Bid Bond for a sum no less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid and subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders must be submitted with each Bid. Bids may not be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the actual date of opening thereof. This time period may be extended by mutual agreement of the Owner and any Bidder or Bidders.

This project is being constructed with assistance from the Michigan Recreational Passport Grant Program. State funds are being utilized, and relevant State requirements will apply.

The City of Mt. Pleasant reserves the right to accept any or all Bids and award the contract to other than the lowest bidder, to waive any irregularities or informalities or both; to reject any or all Bids; and in general to make the award of the Contract in any manner deemed by the OWNER, in its sole discretion, to be in the best interest of the OWNER.

No pre-bid meetings are scheduled for this project at this time.

All work shall be substantially complete by September 14, 2012, with punch list items and final clean-up complete by September 21, 2012.
