GENERAL REQUIREMENT

This work shall be in accordance with the requirements of Section 203 of the Michigan Department of Transportation 2003 Standard Specifications for Construction, except as modified herein.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The Contractor shall maintain pedestrian access throughout the duration of the construction project. This project is located in a downtown setting with businesses and parking areas located on opposite sides of the street. The Contractor shall provide and maintain pedestrian access in all areas of the project where the Contractor is not already working. The Contractor shall provide east and west pedestrian access on at least one side of Michigan Street at all times. When working in the intersections, the Contractor shall provide north and south pedestrian access across Michigan Street and at least one side of the intersection at all times. The Contractor shall also provide "Pedestrian Access Closed" and "Pedestrian Access Route" signage, along with directional arrows, wherever pedestrian access is restricted.

CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES

The Contractor shall minimize the length of time a pedestrian access route is closed and the number of times pedestrians must cross Michigan Street due to pedestrian access closures. The Contractor shall place, maintain, and relocate signage as required by construction and indicated by the attached detail. All costs involved in maintaining pedestrian access, including the placement, maintenance, and relocation of signage shall be included in the Sidewalk, Conc, ___ inch pay item.
