- VI. **DEPARTMENT REPORTS**
  - A. **Parks** – Director Bundy reminded Comm. of planned tour of Indian Pines Park on May 10. Letter sent to property owners on the northerly border of the park outlining the intention of the City (clean-up efforts, signage).  
**GRLI Grant** – working with SCIT, secured funds for the following projects; this will be done in two phases:  
Chipp-a-Waters & Mill Pond Parks:
    - 1) removal of dead trees down and those that are still standing but dead or diseased, and
    - 2) tree revetment along riverbank**Operational:** Nets, picnic tables out, irrigation on, all restrooms to be opened by May 1.
  - B. **Recreation** – Director Longoria reported on the following:
    - Practices started for youth soccer & tee-ball – numbers up by 120 participants.
    - Farmer’s market vendor packets have been mailed – staff planning an opening day kickoff event.
    - Egg Scramble event was successful with volunteers from MPHS Key Club.
    - Sponsorship Packet – mostly complete; staff edits and additional research ongoing.
    - CACFP snack reimbursement for PEAK afterschool up and running.
    - Appointed two PEAK Site Coordinators due to of vacancies – Brooke Rowley for Pullen site and Olivia Blocher for Fancher/McGuire sites.
