

2011 Construction Projects

Major Street Projects

- **Fancher Street**

Fancher Street between High and Michigan Streets will be reconstructed this year. The reconstruction work includes the removal of the existing pavement, curb and gutter, installation of new sanitary and storm sewer lines, reconstruction of the street, and paving of all drive approaches in the area from the street to the sidewalk. Bike route signage will also be installed.

Local Street Projects

- **Chippewa Street**

Chippewa Street between Brown and Russell Streets will be reconstructed in 2011. The street is scheduled for new water main, new sanitary sewer, storm sewer upgrades in select areas, and curb and gutter replacement in select areas.

- **Wisconsin Street**

Wisconsin Street between Fancher and Lansing Street will also be reconstructed in the summer of 2011. The work includes new sanitary sewer and street reconstruction. In addition, all driveway approaches along the construction route, between the street and sidewalk, will be replaced.

Asphalt Overlays

The existing pavement will be removed and a new layer of asphalt applied on the following streets:

- Andre – Main to Fancher
- Anna – Maple to dead end
- Center – Crawford to dead end
- Cooley – Pickard to Elm
- Country Way – Orchard Lane to Crawford
- Crestwood – Orchard to Country Way
- Franklin – Pickard to dead end
- Gaylord – Brown to Crapo
- Heidi – Broadway to dead end
- Lansing – Broadway to Cherry
- Locust – Oak to dead end
- Maple – University to dead end
- Neier – Elm to Pickard
- Orchard Lane – Crestwood to Country Way
- Palmer – Franklin to University
- Thomas – High to North Drive
