Who can attend PEAK?

Children, grades K-6, will discover the awesome benefits of education, recreation, and service learning through a variety of daily activities: sports, arts, crafts, creative expression, cultural and educational enrichments.

When is PEAK offered?

PEAK follows the Mt. Pleasant Public Schools calendar. PEAK will be offered on all full days of school. PEAK is closed on school holidays, snow days, professional development days or early dismissal, scheduled or otherwise.

Where is PEAK held?

PEAK After School is held at the following Mt. Pleasant Public Schools: Ganiard, Pullen, Vowles, McGuire, and Fancher Elementary Schools.

What does the daily schedule look like?

(Sample; actual times may vary by site)

Is transportation available?

Transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian; bussing is not available. Children need to be signed out by 6 p.m. each day. I-Ride may be contacted for transportation services at 989-772-9441. It is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to contact I-Ride; please indicate a pick-up time of 5:30 p.m. or earlier, when utilizing these services.

Is there a snack provided?

The program will provide an afternoon snack each day. If your child has specific food needs, please send your own.

What is Academic time?

Time is set aside for homework assistance Monday through Thursday. Participants who do not have homework will participate in hands-on educational related activities.

What is enrichment time?

A variety of recreational enrichment time activities are available from which to choose. Refer to your PEAK site individual flyer for a calendar and a complete description of available enrichment activities. Enrichment activity fees, if any, will be announced in advance.

What is the cost to attend?

Payment Schedule

Payments for the first two weeks are expected at the time of enrollment. After that, payments are due in advance on a weekly basis (you may also pay in advance for more than one week).

All payments must be received before services will be rendered. If payment is received after the week has begun, you will be charged \$11 a day.

Credit will not be given for days your child does not attend PEAK unless school is cancelled or your child is sick.

Make checks payable to MPPR.

Non-Payments

Individuals that do not submit payment in full within that two week period will be denied access to the program and will be denied future participation in Mt. Pleasant Parks and Recreation programs until the account has been settled.

PEAK's Mission

PEAK, Partners Empowering All Kids, is designed to provide all school age children with educational, enrichment, and recreational activities in a fun and safe environment by keeping schools open until 6 p.m. on school days and turning schools into community centers for kids during the summer months.

FUN Fridays

FUN Fridays consist of special events, movies, assemblies, and local area field trips. All on-site activities are closed when field trips are planned. Participants must attend the field trip or find an alternate activity for that day; the site will be closed. Field trip fees, if any, will be announced in advance.

Enrollment Process

Advance registration is required. All enrollments will be taken at the Mt. Pleasant Parks and Recreation Office in City Hall, by mail or walk-in, using the attached registration form. An individual registration form must be completed for each child and submitted prior to attendance. Please allow 48 hours to process your registration.

Late Pick Up

You will be assessed a \$5 per child late fee for the first 10 minutes you are late picking up your child(ren) and an additional \$1 for every minute thereafter.

Scholarships

It is the goal of the PEAK After School Program for all children to be able to attend after school educational and enrichment programs regardless of personal financial situation. Scholarships are awarded according to the Free and Reduced Lunch Income Guidelines; verification required. If you do not meet Free and Reduced Lunch Income Guidelines, and are in need of financial assistance, you may complete a Scholarship Application, which is available at the Parks and Recreation Office.

Assistance for Special Needs

PEAK partners closely with Mount Pleasant Public Schools, the Gratiot Isabella RESD, and other community organizations to provide an educational and fun outlet for people of all abilities. Persons with disabilities needing assistance to participate may call the Parks and Recreation Office at 989-779-5331. Persons requiring speech or hearing assistance may contact the City through the Michigan Relay Center at 1-800-649-3777.

Opting Out

You may choose to opt out of participation in the PEAK program at any time. Please write a letter to inform the site coordinator at your school if your child will no longer be attending.
