Major construction work planned for Broadway

MT. PLEASANT, Mich., June 12, 2014 – Detours and delays can be expected as construction is set to begin June 16 on the West Broadway Street Reconstruction Project.

The project, which is expected to last through August 29, consists of the removal and replacement of the existing curb and gutter, asphalt, and road base from Bradley to Harris streets. Broadway Street will be closed to through traffic and detoured from Broadway to Leaton Street, Leaton to Fessenden Avenue, proceeding on Fessenden to Bradley Street.

Construction workers from Crawford Contracting, Inc. of Mt. Pleasant plan to be on site Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. At this time, no weekend or holiday work is scheduled. There will be no open excavation during the overnight hours. Pedestrian access will also be maintained at all times by only closing one corner on an intersection at a time.
