Final steps of city manager search process underway

MT. PLEASANT, Mich., June 17, 2014 – Three candidates selected by the Mt. Pleasant City Commission will move forward with the city manager search process beginning June 23. City officials are encouraging residents to participate in the final steps of the process, which include a public reception and interviews.

Candidates include Nancy Ridley, Interim Mt. Pleasant City Manager, Peter Olson, currently employed at Yorktown, Indiana, and Robert Bruner, interim leadership in Mt. Clemens and previously with the City of Birmingham. A public reception for the top three candidates will be held from 5 to 6:30 p.m. During the reception, members of the public will have the opportunity to meet the candidates; and beginning at 5:45 p.m. each candidate will provide the general public with a short introduction of themselves.

Tuesday, June 24

Special Meeting of the City Commission begins at 9 a.m. for interviews of the three candidates. Interviews are scheduled for 9:30 a.m., 11:15 a.m., and 1:30 p.m.

Wednesday, June 25

Special Meeting of the City Commission to be held at 5 p.m. to review and discuss the candidates and select the new city manager.
