NOTICE OF BROADWAY STREET RIVERBANK RESTORATION AND MILL POND WEIR REPAIR PROJECTS

MT. PLEASANT, MI, August 7, 2015 – The City of Mt. Pleasant would like to inform citizens and visitors that river and riverbank construction will begin Monday, August 10. The project includes major repairs of the Mill Pond Park weirs and extensive riverbank repair on Broadway Street across from Nelson Park. The project will affect recreational river access and use throughout the City parks system. The Leaton Street entrance to Mill Pond Park will be closed beginning Monday, August 10 for the duration of the project and daytime traffic shifts will occur on Broadway Street near Nelson Park.

Barring inclement weather, the projects are set to be complete in mid-September. To avoid river construction, recreational tubing, kayaks, and canoes are discouraged from using the river between Chipp-a-Waters Park downstream to Nelson Park for approximately one-month during the construction period. The GKB Riverwalk Trail will remain open in all locations during the project.
