Beaverton man leads police on chase after causing an accident

MT. PLEASANT, Mich. – On March 27, 2017, at approximately 8:45 p.m., Mt. Pleasant police officers responded to a hit-and-run accident at the intersection of Mission and High. A witness observed the accident and watched the suspect flee the scene. The witness provided Central Dispatch with the suspect's vehicle information and the direction in which it was traveling. The suspect vehicle continued northbound on Mission Street and merged onto US-127. Mt. Pleasant officers located and attempted to stop the vehicle by activating their emergency lights and siren, but the vehicle continued northbound for about two miles before stopping. The driver was identified as Nathaniel Horn, a 21-year-old male from Beaverton.

Horn was lodged on charges of Fleeing and Eluding, and Leaving the Scene of an Accident. Horn's bond was set at \$8,000/ten percent.
