Mt. Pleasant man driving moped leads police on chase

MT. PLEASANT, Mich. April 14, 2016 – At approximately 9:09 p.m. on April 13, 2016, an officer on general patrol observed a moped driving on Oak Street. The moped was missing a registration sticker and the driver was not sitting on the moped properly.

The officer attempted to stop the moped, but the driver of the moped accelerated down Pine Street. A brief pursuit ensued until the driver left the roadway near the cul-de-sac of Locust Street. As he crossed the railroad tracks, the driver lost control of the moped and continued to flee on foot. After a short foot pursuit, the driver was apprehended in Mill Pond Park.

The driver, a 26-year-old Mt. Pleasant man, was arrested and lodged at the Isabella County Jail on charges of flee and elude, resisting and obstructing, and driving while license suspended. The matter will be turned over to the Saginaw Chippewa Tribal Prosecutor.
