Mt. Pleasant Fire Department responds to residential structure fire

MT. PLEASANT, Mich. – On Sept. 16 at 8:01 a.m., the Mt. Pleasant Fire Department responded to a structure fire located at 1836 Woods Way with two engines, a rescue truck, an aerial ladder and other support vehicles. The property is a two-story residential structure. During our initial assessment of the scene we found fire conditions in a second-floor bedroom and extending through the roof at the rear of the home.

Engines were set up in the front of the structure and an aggressive interior fire attack was initiated. The fire was brought under control at approximately 9 a.m. The fire caused extensive damage to the building. The home was being renovated at the time of the fire and was not occupied. Thirty-one firefighters from three departments assisted in firefighting operations.

The Deerfield Fire Department, Saginaw Chippewa Tribal Fire Department, Shepherd Tri-Township Fire Department and Mobile Medical Rescue provided support during this incident.

No injuries were reported. The fire remains under investigation at this time.
