Robbery suspect outstanding after demanding prescription drugs

MT. PLEASANT, Mich. March 10, 2015 – Mt. Pleasant police officers responded to a robbery over prescription drugs at about 10:45 a.m. today in the 800th block of Whitney Street.

The suspect knocked on the victim's front door, stepped inside, and locked the door behind him. He never spoke, and instead showed a hand-written note that read: "give me all the money and drugs." The victim stated the suspect then pointed a gun at him and got away with less than \$100 in cash and some prescription medication. There were no injuries.

It appears the victim was targeted and there is no reason to believe the community is in any danger. He waited about 25 minutes before calling police. The suspect is described as a white male, about 6 feet tall, wearing blue jeans, a dark blue sweatshirt, a camouflage ski mask and black leather gloves.

Schools in the area were put into lockdown per safety protocol for about an hour. The incident remains under investigation.
