Election inspectors needed for fall 2016 elections

MT. PLEASANT, Mich. – The City of Mt. Pleasant is hiring election inspectors for the August 2 Primary and November 8 General elections.

Election inspectors play a fundamental role in the democratic process assisting voters in casting their ballots. By diligently following the procedures set by election law, election inspectors protect voters' rights and deliver accurate election results.

Duties of Inspector:

- Verifying voter identification
- Performing computer search functions
- Electronic logging of voters, ballots issued and special circumstances
- Reconciling voter registration issues
- Instructing and guiding voters through the voting process

Requirements for Appointment:

- Registered Voter in Michigan
- Skilled laptop user
- Able to interact with public in a professional, friendly manner
- Completion of training
- Not a candidate or relative of a candidate appearing on the ballot
- No felony or election crime convictions

Inspectors earn \$10 an hour. They are also paid for training.

Those interested must complete an application, criminal history background check authorization form, and Fair Credit Reporting Act disclosure and authorization. Application forms are available at City Hall (320 W. Broadway) and www.mt-pleasant.org. The deadline to apply is June 10.
