City seeks input from kids on design of Island Park Playscape 2.0;

Community-wide design night planned for May 5

MT. PLEASANT, Mich. – To prepare for the rebuild of the community’s treasured TimberTown Playscape at Island Park this fall, Mt. Pleasant is asking area children to describe their visions of their dream playground to incorporate into the design of Island Park Playscape 2.0.

On Thursday, May 5 at 7 p.m., Isabella County kids of all ages and their families are invited to Veterans Memorial Library to share their ideas with a playground design team from Sinclair Recreation and GameTime Playgrounds. Participating children are also encouraged to bring a drawing of their dream playground to give to designers as inspiration for the final creation.

In addition to community-wide design night, the team will visit various elementary schools during school hours this week to gather input. Children will be asked to draw, sketch or paint what they would like to see in a local playscape.
